If adopted, the fiscal impact, over a five-year period, is projected to generate between \$13,640,000 and \$20,487,500 in capital expansion revenue for the County from impact fees. The revenue would be distributed among nine categories: Fire Rescue, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), Law Enforcement, Correctional Facilities, General Government Buildings, Library Facilities, Parks and Recreation, Environmentally Sensitive Lands, and Roads.
